Have your child write **their** name on the back. Your child will deliver these themselves. There are 14 students.

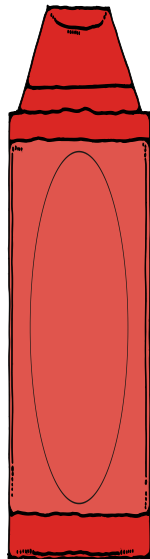
