Directions:

1. **Create an outline** for your paper. (**NOTE: DO THIS FIRST.**) Follow the plan for the rough draft, below, to create the outline. The outline does not have to be in complete sentences. It will be handed in with the rough draft. See the attached sheet for a sample outline.
2. **Write the rough draft** of your paper. It should be structured as follows:

Introductory Paragraph

- a sentence or sentences introducing the topic of Christian heroes
- your thesis statement
- transition sentence (to get you into the next paragraph)

Paragraph 2

- topic sentence for key idea #1
- two or more sentences that support and explain key idea #1

Paragraph 3

- topic sentence for key idea #2
- two or more sentences that support and explain key idea #2

Paragraph 4

- topic sentence for key idea #3
- two or more sentences that support and explain key idea #3

Concluding Paragraph

- summarize by recapping who your hero is and what makes that person your hero
- end your paper with one or two wrap-up sentences
