 - Providing spiritual guidance and support to team members
 - Facilitating students to serve in the team's ministry projects
 - Assisting/supporting the trip leader
 - Encouraging all team members
- **Please remember that all chaperones will follow the entire group schedule.**
- **This application is to be completed and turned in with a \$100 non-refundable check (made out to LCA)** to Lauren Erena by October 17.
- Team leaders are encouraged to attend any organized team meetings.
- **All trip costs are the team member's responsibility and are due according to the payment schedule (see below).**
- If you are unable to participate in the trip, please notify Lauren Erena in writing via email, as soon as possible. If you cancel your trip after monies have been paid out on your behalf, you will be held financially responsible for this amount.
- **Monies put towards mission trips are tax-deductible contributions, and the Internal Revenue Service prohibits the refund of such contributions. No exceptions can be made.** Please do NOT write your name on the memo line of your check.
- Any monies raised over the needed trip cost may be used for a mission trip for the following school year only. This may be used by you or an immediate family member. It may not be transferred to any other team member or leader. If you do not go on a mission trip the following year, the money will be deposited into the missions account and used for needed team items (such as VBS supplies).

Atlanta Payment Schedule (\$400* total):

*Note: Parents/chaperones pay an additional \$50 for hotel accommodations because there are only two adults per room as opposed to 4-6 students per room.
