Dear Parents,

Your child has expressed an interest in being a part of CRAVE Crew Set-up Team. I am excited about the possible opportunity of working with your child. As part of the process I ask that you take the time to help your child understand the importance of filling out the application thoroughly and completely. Many students disqualify themselves simply because they don't take the time to really think about the questions on the application and fill it out completely. Although the application is lengthy, it plays an integral part in the selection process.

This crew has the responsibility each week of setting up the chairs for CRAVE. They must come ready to accomplish the task in a timely manner. They also stay after CRAVE each week and stack the chairs back up. This also must be performed in a timely fashion.

They usually end up missing a portion of their special class each Thursday. Therefore, they must be diligent to find out any work they may miss and complete it. Also, they must be conscientious enough to pack up before they come to CRAVE each week since they will help stack the chairs right up until dismissal time.

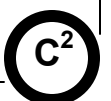

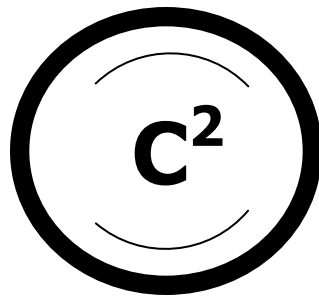

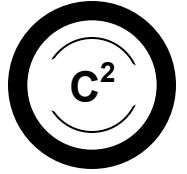

- Do you have a quiet time? If so, include when, how often, what you study, etc. **(It's okay if you don't. Honesty is more important than attempting to impress.)**

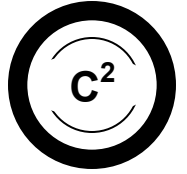

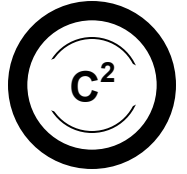

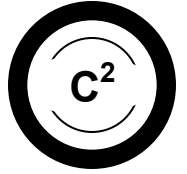

BY APPLYING for the CRAVE CREW, I understand my conduct should reflect my commitment to Christ at all times, and I am willing to be held accountable for my actions.

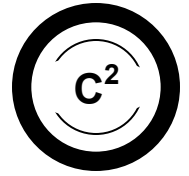

Set-up and Tear Down Crew (all spots are open) – This crew is divided into several teams depending upon the number of students that apply for this position. Each team is then put on a rotation schedule.

This crew has the responsibility each week of setting up the chairs for CRAVE. They must come ready to accomplish the task in a timely manner. They also stay after CRAVE each week and stack the chairs back up. This also must be performed in a timely fashion.

They usually end up missing a portion of their special class each Thursday. Therefore, they must be diligent to find out any work they may miss and complete it. Also, they must be conscientious enough to pack up before they come to CRAVE each week since they will help stack the chairs right up until dismissal time.

Worship Leaders (0 spots available) – This group is also divided into several vocal teams based upon the number of students that apply. Each team is then put on a rotation schedule.

They will be the primary people responsible for leading their peers in worship each week in CRAVE. They must be willing to spend time learning new music and be comfortable teaching new songs to others.

They must have the ability to blend their voice with the other worship leaders, yet still sing loud enough to lead the congregation in worship. Occasionally, they may be asked to sing a solo and must be diligent in spending time outside of rehearsal learning the melody and the lyrics.

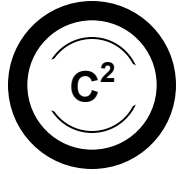
(This position does require a vocal audition. The student must be prepared to sing the following two worship songs: 1. Your Love is Deep. 2. No One Like You.)

Tech Crew (0 spot available) – This crew will also be divided into several teams based upon the number of people that apply. Each team is then put on a rotation schedule.

Each week the team will assist Mr. Fudd in setting up and taking down all the technical equipment. They also will be responsible for the set up, tear down and management of any sets or props.

Each member of the team will be assigned a specific job on the team that will be their primary expertise; although they will be expected to be able to perform any job on the team. The jobs are as follows: Sound Board Technician, MultiMedia Technician, Lighting Technician, Video Camera Technician and Stage Manager, Crew Chief, Video Director, Photographer, and Teleprompter.

(Jobs within each crew will be determined after a week of training and assessment).



9 Job Descriptions (Cont'd)

Drama Crew (0 spots available) – This crew is made up of 4 to 6 members each year.

Students must love to be crazy, silly, and spontaneous and yet have the ability to be serious when needed. Must be willing to spend time on the own learning and rehearsing their scripts due to limited time to rehearse during school hours.

(This position requires a drama audition. They will be asked to memorize a short monologue and perform a spontaneous reading during the audition)

Prayer Crew (several spots available) – Students who apply for this crew are placed in a rotation and come 5 to 10 minutes before CRAVE each week and lead the CRAVE Crew in prayer.

They also will periodically receive emails from Mr. Fudd with prayers concerns. Their role to help bathe CRAVE and the topics we deal with each week in prayer.
