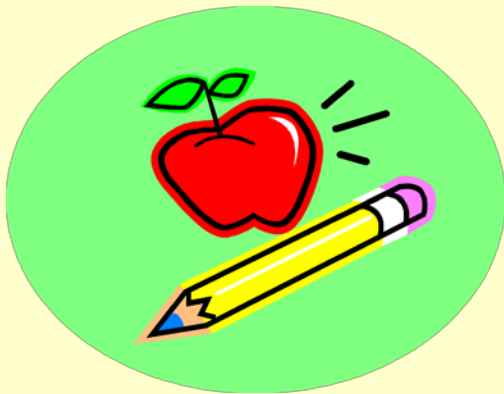

17 has 1 ten and 7 ones

$$17 = 10 + 7$$

23 has 2 tens and 3 ones

$$23 = 20 + 3$$

Phonics

We will be learning that ck follows a short vowel (duck) and ke follows a long vowel (bike); qu in queen, pr in pray, gr in grin, sm in smoke and sc in scat. We will continue to work on the 1 and 2 vowel rule and k before i and e, c before the other three.
